

# REGULATIONS FOR CUBE AND MOOD BOULDER GYM

*Sport climbing and bouldering are considered high-risk sports. To ensure maximum safety, it is essential to strictly adhere to these regulations; however, even when all precautions are taken, bouldering may still carry the risk of bodily injury or health impairment. Use of the bouldering facilities is at the sole responsibility of the climbers.*

The MOOD and CUBE bouldering facilities are operated by CUBE WALLS Sp. z o.o. Sp.k., based in Kraków ("CUBE WALLS").

## PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS:

1. **Individuals using the bouldering facilities are required to familiarize themselves with these regulations, accept them, and strictly comply with their provisions. Parents/guardians of minors using the facilities must also familiarize themselves with these regulations, accept them, and communicate the safety rules outlined here to the minors.**
2. Regardless of the above, purchasing an entry ticket or beginning to use the bouldering facility is equivalent to accepting these regulations.
3. When events are held in the bouldering facilities, parts of the facility or specific walls may be closed for general use. Clients will be informed of this before purchasing an entry ticket.

## AGE RESTRICTIONS:

4. **Minors who are at least 16 years old** may use the bouldering facilities on their own, only with the written consent of their parents or legal guardians. They may also use the facility with written consent from an adult supervisor who is not their parent or legal guardian.
5. **Minors under the age of 16** may only use the bouldering facility with written consent from their parents, legal guardians, or an adult supervisor, and **only under the direct supervision of an adult – an instructor, parent, legal guardian, or another responsible adult. Minors under the age of 16 cannot use the bouldering facility on their own.**
6. **Parents or guardians bear full responsibility for the behavior of minors. The use of the bouldering facility by children or teenagers under 18 based on consent is entirely at the risk of the parent/guardian.**
7. The bouldering facility does not provide supervision for children or teenagers. Entrusting supervision to the facility's staff is dependent on the availability of this service. Prior arrangements must be made with the staff, and explicit approval is required.
8. **Individual and group activities organized by CUBE WALLS are intended for adults unless otherwise specified in the activity offer. Before registering for participation in any activity, it should be confirmed whether minors are eligible to participate.**

## GROUP ENTRY RULES:

9. Organized groups may use the bouldering facility only with prior approval from the staff. Conducting business or training activities at the facility may only take place with prior consent from the staff.
10. In matters not covered by specific agreements or instructions from the staff regarding group entry conditions and use of the bouldering facility, the provisions of these regulations apply, particularly safety rules and age restrictions.
11. In the case of visits by organized groups whose members are under 18, a group supervisor must be present during the climbing session. A single supervisor may oversee a maximum of 15 people.
12. The responsibility for the safety of members of organized groups or individuals participating in activities (regardless of the form) lies with the group supervisor or the person conducting business or training activities.
13. The group supervisor or activity leader is also responsible for communicating the content of the regulations to all group members, either personally or through legal guardians.

14. For organized groups, if the group supervisor lacks sufficient knowledge and experience in bouldering, supervision by an instructor assigned by the bouldering facility is required.

#### **RULES FOR ACTIVITIES ORGANIZED BY CUBE WALLS:**

15. To participate in activities, punctual attendance is required. For organizational or safety reasons, the instructor may refuse participation to individuals who are late.
16. Leaving the facility or activity area before the end of the session should be communicated to the instructor in advance.
17. Tardiness may result in forfeiting participation in the given session, especially if the spot has been taken by someone from the waiting list.
18. Before the start of the session, it is mandatory to inform the instructor of any health issues, injuries, pregnancy, or other conditions that may limit the ability to perform exercises.
19. CUBE WALLS is not responsible for negative consequences from exercises performed independently, without following or contrary to the instructor's instructions.
20. The instructor may refuse participation in the session to anyone whose health condition may pose a risk to themselves or others. Individuals who behave inappropriately, pose a safety risk, or violate these regulations may be removed from the session.
21. Participants in the sessions are required to immediately comply with the instructions of the staff or the session instructors.

#### **SAFETY RULES:**

22. Individuals climbing for the first time or those who lack knowledge about climbing and bouldering safety rules must inform the staff before starting to climb.
23. Individuals who behave inappropriately, pose a safety risk, or violate these regulations may be removed from the bouldering facility.
24. Users of the bouldering facility are required to immediately comply with the instructions of the bouldering facility staff.
25. Moving equipment within the facility without staff approval is prohibited.
26. After use, equipment must be returned to its designated place.
27. When using the bouldering facility, it is mandatory to wear climbing shoes or other suitable sports shoes and appropriate clothing that does not contain hard elements or objects in pockets.
28. **In the bouldering area, the following are strictly prohibited:**
  - a) **Staying in the fall zone beneath the climbing wall, sitting or walking on mats under climbers;**
  - b) **Leaving any objects on the mats in the fall zone beneath the wall;**
  - c) Loosening or adjusting holds independently;
  - d) Using the structural elements of the wall during climbing;
  - e) **Climbing with jewelry on hands**, wearing watches, or other clothing elements that pose a danger to the climber or others;
  - f) Climbing in unsuitable footwear, without shoes, or in inappropriate clothing containing hard elements or objects in pockets;
  - g) **Climbing under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating substances;**
  - h) Smoking, consuming alcohol, or bringing weapons or sharp and dangerous tools.
29. Any observed technical irregularities, defects, or loose holds must be reported to the staff immediately.
30. Bringing pets into the facility is allowed, provided that this is reported to the staff and the animal is appropriately secured (e.g., leash, muzzle). It is prohibited to bring animals into the fall zone beneath the climbing wall or onto the protective mats.
31. For the health and comfort of the bouldering facility users, individuals showing visible symptoms of a cold or similar illnesses may be denied entry or asked to leave the facility.
32. Individuals with skin conditions are required to use their own mats or equipment or wear appropriate footwear.

## **RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY**

33. Users of the bouldering facility are responsible for securing their personal belongings. The facility operator is not responsible for losses resulting from the negligence of users, including items left behind or lost in the facility, locker rooms, or waiting areas. Valuable or fragile items (such as phones, cameras, etc.) should be secured properly or left outside the facility. Items found within the facility should be handed over to the reception. Lost items are returned after identification by the owner within three weeks from the date they were left.
34. Each person uses the bouldering facility at their own exclusive responsibility and risk, taking into account their abilities, skills, and health condition. This also applies to parents and guardians who consent to the use of the facility by minors and supervise them during climbing. Parents/guardians are fully responsible for the safety of their children and for any damages caused by minors.
35. Individuals using the bouldering facility or the parents/guardians of minors accept that CUBE WALLS is not liable for damages (including bodily injuries) resulting from non-compliance with these regulations or safety rules, as well as for any other damages incurred as a result of using the bouldering facility. At the same time, the aforementioned individuals waive any claims against CUBE WALLS or other entities for damages incurred while using the facility.
36. CUBE WALLS is not responsible for accidents resulting from non-compliance with these regulations or improper use of the bouldering facility.
37. Each person using the bouldering facility is required to have personal accident insurance covering sports climbing.
38. Individuals engaging in climbing understand and accept that their personal actions and interactions ultimately determine personal safety and the safety of others. Understanding and respecting safety rules are fundamental to the health and safety of individuals within the bouldering facility.
39. In the event of any accidents, unforeseen events, improper behavior by users or their guardians, or observed defects in the bouldering facility, the staff must be notified immediately.
40. For safety purposes, the facility operator reserves the right to use video surveillance.

## **PERSONAL DATA AND IMAGE RIGHTS**

41. The administrator of personal data is CUBE WALLS. The full content of the information clause regarding personal data protection is available at the bouldering facility's reception.
42. Individuals using the bouldering facility, or the parents/guardians of minors, consent to the free use and distribution of the image of those using the facility, which may be recorded during their stay, for the purposes of promoting the bouldering facility and the activities of CUBE WALLS. This consent includes the publication of photos on the MOOD, CUBE and CUBE WALLS websites, as well as on their social media profiles. The consent is granted for an indefinite period and without territorial limitations. At the same time, the aforementioned individuals consent to the processing of personal data by CUBE WALLS in the scope of the use of their image.
